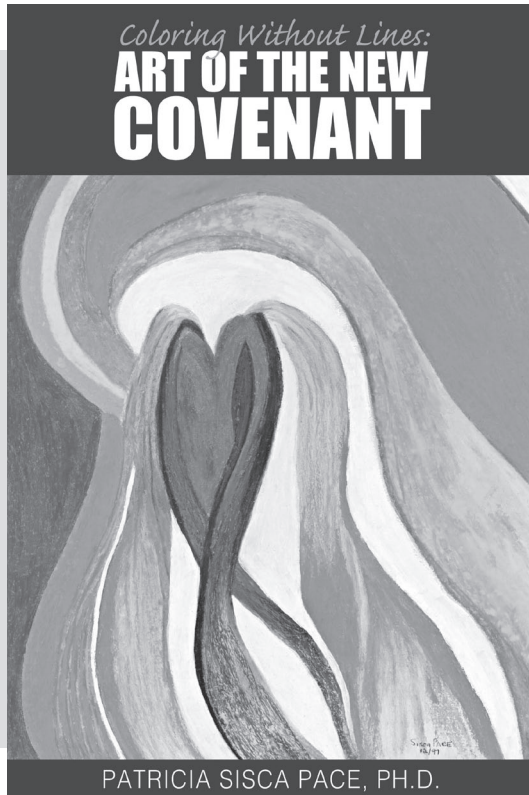


# 2 Autumn Art Retreats

### Program 1: HSPT ACADEMICS

3 Sundays, September 9, 16, 23, from 10:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.

**COST:** \$130

### Program 2: HSPT ACADEMICS

2 Sundays, October 7 and 14, from 10:00 a.m. to 1:45 p.m.

**COST:** \$130

Both of the above Academic programs cover all areas of the HSPT: Math, Reading, Grammar & Cognitive. Dr. Pace includes her unique strategies, a review of all test subject areas, practice tests, a daily Progress Report, homework, and a parent meeting.

### Program 3: HSPT BASICS
