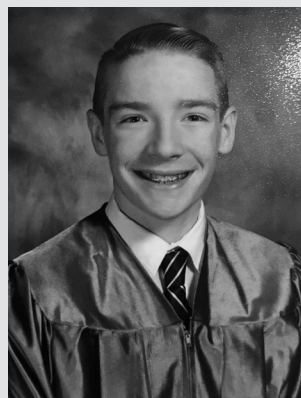
The following is a partial list of students who took one of Dr. Pace's SAT seminars, who substantially increased their SAT scores, and who agreed to have their accomplishments posted.

Francesca | Saint Mary Interparochial



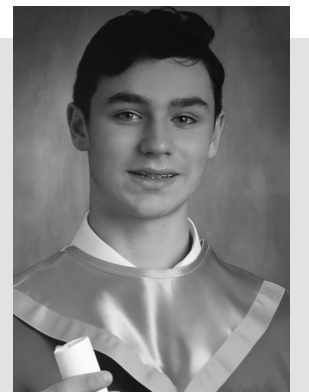

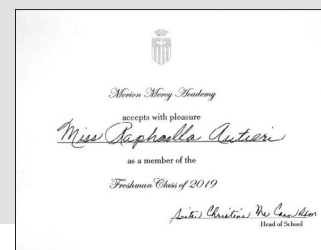

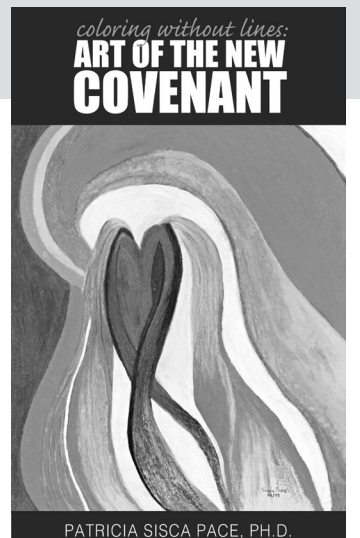
