DAMYA WALTON, Merion Mercy Academy

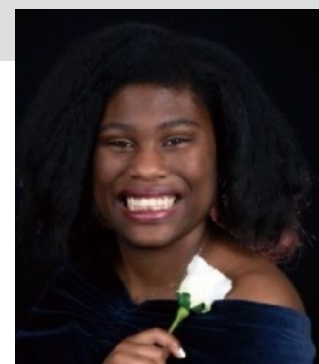
