

(Students enrolled in this program can attend one of my 2016 Winter or Spring 2-hour SAT Refreshers for free!) PROGRAM DESCRIPTION: Each of the first 4 days of his program has 3 parts:

- 1. In the first part of the class (about 40 minutes), parents and students together learn a holistic component of the program. This section of the class has been designed to help students and parents learn how to effectively deal with factors (such as low confidence, distractions, anxiety, and fatigue) that work against personal best performance. Dr. Pace teaches techniques that build trust, confidence, clear-headedness and focus, and she offers a plan of action that will promote physical, emotional, mental, and spiritual well-being on test day.
- 2. In the second part of the class, Dr. Pace works with parents on the holistic component while students take a section of the new SAT. Parents leave after part 2.
- 3. In the third part of the class, Dr. Pace teaches SAT academics to students, emphasizing information and strategies (Dr. Pace's unique tricks of the trade!) specifically geared for the Reading, Math, Grammar, and Essay sections on the new SAT.

On March 5, the last day of the program, parents will gather for an hour with Dr. Pace while their children are taking the SAT at the test site.


